Galatians 1:1-24

I. Paul Delivers An Apostolic Greeting To The Galatians (1-5)

A. The Simple Statement (1a-1b) [Reveals God’s Messenger]

1. The Man God Called (1a) Paul,
2. The Ministry God Chose (1b) an apostle,

B. The Sovereign Source (1c-1g) [Reveals God’s Ministry]

1. Paul Is Not An Apostle By Any Human Causes (1c-1d)
 - a. Not By Pronouncements Of Human Councils (1c) (not of men,
[Not Earthly Declarations])
 - b. Not By Promotions Of Human Choosing (1d) neither by man,
[Not Ego Driven]
2. Paul Is Now An Apostle By The Almighty’s Holy Choice (1e-1g)
 - a. Chosen By His Personal Savior (1e) but by Jesus Christ,
 - b. Chosen By His Powerful Sovereign (1f-1g)
 - (1) The Father God (1f) and God the Father,
 - (2) The Father’s Greatness (1g) who raised him from the dead;

C. The Spiritual Salutation (2-3) [Reveals God’s Mercy]

1. The Pronouncement Of The Salutation (2)
 - a. Sent From The Christians In Grace (2a)
And all the brethren which are with me,
 - b. Sent To The Churches In Galatia (2b) unto the churches of Galatia:
2. The Particulars In The Salutation (3a-3b)
 - a. The Spiritual Foundation Of Grace That Was Theirs (3a)
Grace be to you
 - b. The Spiritual Fruit Of Grace That Was Theirs (3b) and peace
3. The Provision Of The Salutation (3c-3d)
 - a. The Divine Fountain Of Grace And Peace(3c) from God the Father,
 - b. The Divine Flow Of Grace And Peace (3d)
and from our Lord Jesus Christ,

D. The Sacrificial Salvation (4-5) [Reveals God’s Method]

1. God’s Grace For Men Is Only Through Christ (4)
